Scope

Karlka FenceWright was contracted by Nexus in support of the road and rail Toowoomba Second Range Crossing project.

The team were tasked with supplying and installing over 20,000 lineal metres (lm) of Koala-proof fence, 14,000lm of concrete anti-dig plinth, and 15,000lm of various chainmesh types.

Challenges

A large road/rail project such as Nexus presents a host of challenges. One of the main challenges the team experienced was interfacing with multiple contractors in the same work area and managing to adhere to strict timelines with often changing scopes.

Solutions

Multiple contractors from different companies on site at the same time can present timing, logistical, and safety challenges. The Karlka FenceWright team followed its strict OH&S policies, procedures, and practices to ensure all staff worked in a safe environment.

The team also communicated regularly and efficiently to ensure everyone was on the same page and understood what was required at every stage of the project. This helped to manage the changing project scope and ensured the project still met its strict delivery timeframes.

Scope

In support of the Carseldine Station Park & Ride Project, Karlka FenceWright was contracted by Queensland Bridge & Civil to:

- Supply and install approximately 90 lineal meters (lm) of 2,000mm-high treated timber fencing, with steel posts to meet Queensland Rail specification QR-C-S3231.
- Supply and install approximately 575lm of 1,500mm-high HDG and powder coated tubular loop top fencing, according to Queensland Rail specification QR-C-S3233.
- Supply and install approximately 110lm of 1,800mm / 2,100mm-high chain wire mesh fencing and gates, to meet Queensland Rail specification QR-C-S3429.

Challenges

The project presented various challenges for the Karlka FenceWright team. These included:

- Working with and around other trades on an active and busy building site
- Working to project timeframes and strict client deadlines to ensure timely, smooth operation of the train station and opening of the area to the public.
- Concrete drilling of 1,000+ holes for chemset anchor studs.

Solutions

The Karlka FenceWright's operational and installation team relied upon its robust project and site management systems and practices to ensure they were able to meet strict timeframes and provide quality outcomes for the project.

Our qualified and trained personnel performed all works in accordance with regulations, including RPE Fit tested and On-Tool extraction.

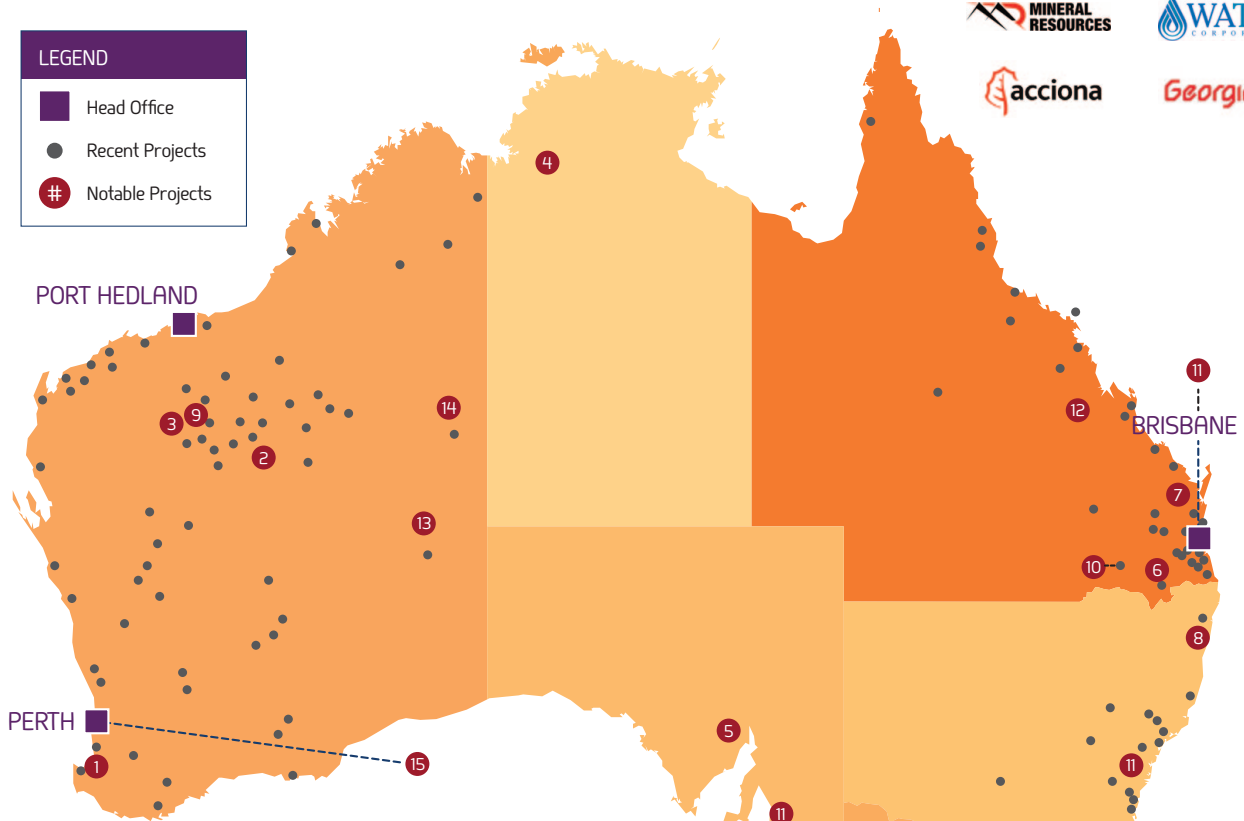
